The Camino Community Action Committee is seeking applications for mini grants that will be used for projects benefiting Camino and its residents in one of these focus areas: serving the school and/or children, increasing the beauty or safety of our community, fostering arts/entertainment, enhancing historical/cultural opportunities, or providing recreational and/or outdoor opportunities. Applicants must be non-profits, or sponsored by a non-profit, that has a project serving Camino and its residents. Applicants can request up to \$600.00 per project. Individuals may apply for funding for no more than two projects per year. Specific projects are ineligible for grant funding after funding in two consecutive grant cycles. Please see the Mini-Grant Guidelines on the CCAC website at <https://www.caminocac.com/>. Funds awarded must be spent by January 29, 2027.

The application is limited to **two pages for narrative, plus a budget page**. You may delete this heading in green on your actual application. Those applicants selected are required to submit a report as outlined in the guidelines. Five points are given for the overall quality of the application.

9. Please provide a budget, using our form, or your form, if it includes all our categories. See the sample budget in the guidelines. Be sure to indicate previous or future sources of income for this project. (20 points)
